

## CMVs, RVs and Schools

---

### RVs AND TRAIERED VESSELS (BOATS)

74-37(f) Recreation vehicles and trailered vessels may be parked on a street for a maximum of 72 hours when necessary for loading, unloading, cleaning or other preparations as may be necessary provided all other restrictions are followed and all driveway and on-site parking is first occupied (or is otherwise unusable) and such vessel is registered (or leased) to the owner or occupier of the residence adjacent to the street on which parked.

### COMMERCIAL VEHICLES (SEE REVERSE FOR DEFINITION)

74-37(h) Commercial vehicles are prohibited from parking in any residential area at any time. Nothing in this section precludes a bona-fide vendor from using a commercial vehicle in conducting legitimate business and for its designed purpose, during such time the business is being conducted.

### SCHOOL PARKING, LOADING & UNLOADING

74-45(a) No person shall load or unload passengers seventeen (17) years of age or younger into or from a vehicle within one-fourth (¼) mile around such school, on the streets, alleyways, cul-de-sacs, right-of-ways, public parking areas, or private parking areas open to the public, or other such areas, unless on the campus proper of the school, within designated loading or unloading areas provided for such purpose, or under the direction of a police officer or school official.

## Common Violations

---

### **74-33(c) Must be parked in the direction of traffic (no left wheels to curb)**

74-33(c) Within 12 inches of the edge of the pavement.

74-33(d) Parked over line in parking space.

74-33(e) Abandoned.

74-33(f) Dismantled or junked vehicle parked on road or right-of-way.

74-34(a) Must leave 12 feet of lane width if parked on roadway.

### **74-34(b) On-street parking prohibited when practicable to park in driveway.**

74-34(c) Must be a clear view of vehicle parked in roadway from a distance of 200'.

74-34(e) On or within 30' of a curve *AND* disrupts the sight picture along the roadway.

74-35(1) Within 15' of a community mailbox except momentarily to drop off mail, between the hours of 8am and 6pm excluding Sundays and federal holidays. Within fifteen (15) feet of a single mail box between the hours of 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., excluding Sunday and Federal Holidays unless the vehicle has a valid registration which lists the street address on which the mail box is located.

74-35(2) Blocking access to commercial or residential refuse container.

74-35(3) Red or yellow painted curb.

### **74-35(4) Disabled only parking. \$250 within five business days; \$260 thereafter.**

74-35(4)(b) Obstructing disabled accessible parking space, curb cut, or access aisle. *\$250 within five business days; \$260 thereafter.*

74-35(5) Within curved area of a cul-de-sac.

74-35(6) Within an intersection or within 30 feet of an intersection approach.

## Common Violations

---

74-35(10) In front of, across from, or along the curb within 12 feet of a public or private driveway, except to momentarily pick-up or drop-off passengers.

74-35(11) On a sidewalk or with any part of the vehicle protruding over the sidewalk.

74-35(14) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant or within 20 feet of a fire station entrance.

74-35(15) Within any fire lane.

74-35(21) Within any space designated for an emergency vehicle.

74-35(22) Within or on a median.

74-35(23) Within or on any off-street right-of-way within the city limits.

74-36 Parking where prohibited by sign or marking.

74-37(a)(1) Curbstoning.

74-37(a)(6) Attached tag not assigned (subject to immediate towing w/o warning).

74-43(a) Park a vehicle upon any street, right-of-way, or any private parking area open to the public, without a current and valid registration license plate and validation sticker.

74-37(f) All rules apply to trailers.

74-37(g) All rules apply to CMVs.

74-37(h) All rules apply to RVs.
